SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is ten (10) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00)----- Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 6th. day of February, 1940, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: Marvin Jacobs, Louis M. Jacobs, and F. A. Schutrum.
