All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the Southwest side of the Laurens Road (also known as U. S. Highway No. 276), about five miles south of the City of Greenville, in Austin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 2.1 acres, and having according to survey made by J. Mac Richardson, surveyor, April 1949, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Laurens Road at the Southeast corner of Lot heretofore conveyed by Grantors to H. D. Phillips, said pin being approximately 750.6 feet in a Southeasterly direction from the point where the Southwest side of Laurens Road intersects with the Southeast side of a 30-foot unnamed road, and running thence along the Phillips line S. 39-32 W. 637 feet to iron pin in the Old Laurens Road; thence along the Old Laurens Road S. 51-57 E. 48.8 feet to iron pin; thence continuing along the Old Laurens Road S. 56-54 E. 101.2 feet to iron pin; thence N. 39-35 E. 605.6 feet to iron pin on the Southwest side of the Laurens Road; thence along the Southwest side of the Laurens Road N. 46-37 W. 150 feet to the beginning corner.
