Know all Men by these Presents, That The City Council of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty 100 DOLLARS, to it in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents, by Reunion Belaw

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents Do Grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Reunion Belaw

dimensions, to-wit: 6 1/2 ft - 7 1/2 ft - 11 1/2 ft - 16 ft - 16 ft -

for the right of burial and cemetery purposes, and to be used exclusively for the right and purpose aforesaid, and subject to the conditions of the Charter of said grantor, and all revisions thereof and amendments that may be made thereto, and also subject to the Ordinances of said City and the rules, regulations and by-laws of the City Council and Cemetery Trustees or Committee, now in force, or which may hereafter be passed, relating to said cemetery and the burial of the dead therein.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances of said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining:

To have and to hold, all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the said Reunion Belaw heirs and assigns forever; subject, however, to the limitations and conditions hereinbefore imposed.

And it does hereby bind itself and its successors in office to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said Reunion Belaw his

Heirs and Assigns, against itself and its successors in office and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

WITNESS the seal of said City Council of Greenville, this 9 day of Oct A. D. 1900, in the year of our Lord one thousand, nine hundred and Eight, and in the one hundred and 20 year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
