Vaughn, on the east by a spring branch and lands of Frady and Boiter and on the south and southwest by lot of Porter Vaughn and Margaret Vaughm and being the lot first described in deed recorded in Deed Book 381 at page 293, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-
