

All of that lot or parcel of land situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, designated and described as follows:

For the beginning point, Begin at the intersection of the center line of U. S. Highway # 176 with the center line of the roadway leading to the residence of Allen Calhoun and running with the center line of said roadway four calls as follows: South 85 deg. 55 min. West 252.25 feet; South 52 deg. 28 min. West 71 feet; South 9 deg. 16 min. East 72 feet; South 37 deg. 57 min. East 126.2 feet to an iron pin driven in the center of said roadway which bears North 78 deg. 10 min. West 41.65 feet from a permanent concrete marker erected on the edge of said road and from said beginning corner as above located running along center of said road South 35 deg. 04 min. East 151.3 fest to a point; thence South 6 deg. 13 min. East 243.1 feet to an iron pin in center of road; thence North 78 deg. 16 min. West 17.65 feet to a reference point marked by iron pin and thence on same course 149.1 feet to a stake; thence South 67 deg. 56 min. West 112.15 feet to a stake; thence South 89 deg. 36 min. West 149.15 feet to a stake; thence North 78 deg. 45 min. West 895.4 feet to a stake; thence North 58 deg. 10 min. West 221.0 feet to a stake; thence worth 3deg. 20 min. West 192.3 feet to a stake; thence North 78 deg. 12 min. East 165.0 feet to a stake; thence North 68 deg. 46 min. East 321.4 feet to an iron pin in the middle of old road; thence South 85 deg. 56 min. East 226.1 feet to a stake; thence South 69 deg. 45 min. East 264.1 feet to a stake in middle of road; thence South 65 deg. 05 min. East 262.0 feet to a stake in middle of road; thence South 78 deg. 10 min. East 203.0 feet to iron pin in middle of road, the BEGINNING corner; containing 14.41 acres, more or less, as shown by survey of H. B. Frankenfield, Jr., Surveyor, May 23rd., 1949, and being portion of tract containing 292 acres conveyed to Julian Calhoun by E. Inman Master, by deeds recorded Book 173, at page 95, dated March 23, 1936 and Vol. 342, at page 233, dated April 2, 1948, Office of R. M. C., Greenville County, S. C.

While this deed covers to center of road, and the adjacent property when sold, will be deed in a like manner, no owner or purchaser shall have the right to close or obstruct the road in any manner or do anything to prevent its use as a public highway, and the right is hereby given by seller and buyer that the road may be widened to as much as twenty feet from the center at any time by property owners or the state or county.
