in the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, for the purpose of locating, constructing, improving, and maintaining the above described street. Bounded

by lands of Buncombe Street on the Northeast, Ora Lee Dauron on the Southeast, other lands of the grantor on the Southwest, Lloyd street on the North-

Described as follows: All that piece, parcel or strip of land beginning on the Southwest side of Buncombe Street in the city og Greenville, S.C., at the common corner between the property of St. James Episcopal Church and that of Ora Lee Damron, and running thence worthwest along buncombe Street 63 feet to the South edge of Lloyd Street, thence Southeasterly across the church property to a point on the property line between St. James Episcopal Church and that of Ora Lee Da mron, thence wortheasterly along said line 6.5 feet to the point of beginning on buncombe Street.
