RENT CONTRACT

Grover 6. Richardson of Greenville, County and State from the county and State owner, lessor or landlord, does hereby rent and lesse the property hereafter designated and described, unto R. Henry Ligon of the City, County and State foresaid, herein sometimes referred to as lessee or tenant, on terms and conditions specified and set forth in this instrument.

It is understood and agreed that a rent contract or lease already exists between the parties hereto concerning the same property. It is set forth in a written contract dated Hovember 25, 1945, as amended by an agreement dated January 23, 1946. By the terms of those two instruments the said R. Henry Ligon is to have possession of said premises as lessee or tenant until October 1, 1949. It is further understood and agreed, however, that this agreement is to supercede that now existing as of January 1, 1949, but until January 1, 1949 the now existing contract is to remain of full force and effect and thereafter it shall cease to exist, with the presently executed instrument becoming effective.

The property which the landlord rents to the tenant is known and designated as the The Clothing Store Building or Room now occupied by the said R. Henry Ligon, and being in the Wallace Building and being located at 16 W. Washington Street.

The purpose of the rent agreement is to permit the said R. Henry Ligon to continue occupation of the said store room or store building until December 31, 1953 as a place of business for the conduct of a clotting store and gents furnishings generally therein.

The said R. Henry Ligon agrees to accept the occupancy of said store building or store room for the time aforesaid as a tenant of the said Grover C. Richardson in accord with the terms and conditions hereof, and agrees and contracts to pay the rental as hereafter specified.
