All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Ward 5 of the City of Greenville, and having the following mates and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of Green Avenue and Arlington Avenue, and running thence along Arlington Avenue, N. 71 W. 103 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 28 E. 95 feet, more or less, to corner of lot now or formerly belonging to C. O. Allen; thence along the line of last mentioned property, S. 64 1/4 E. 99 feet to an iron pin on Green Avenue;
