Cox (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mollie C. Cox All our undivided right, title, and interest in and to

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Acres Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, consisting of 0.25 acres, located on the west side of Highway 25, as per plat thereof recorded in the Public Records for Greenville County in Plat Book W, page 22, and as more especially to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of the line of the Nelson P. Coleman property, and running along the line of said Nelson P. Coleman property, 77 E 112 feet to an iron pin; thence N 38-52 E 206 feet, crossing a line of stone; thence N 20-24 E 218 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of the Carrie C. Henderson property, N 73-15 E 112 feet to an iron pin in the line of Highway 25; thence along the west side of Highway 25, S 28-30 W 302.50 feet to the point of BEGINNING
