SEPARATION AGREEMENT

COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

We, H. G. Williams, husband, and Barbara Williams, wife, for and in consideration of our mutual promises and respective benefits, enter into this separation agreement, to wit:

- lst. The parties hereto shall live separate and apart, neither to molest or interfer with the other;
- 2nd. The wife, Barbara Williams, shall have the custody and control of the two children of the marriage Betty Jo Williams, age 14 years, and Brenda Joyce Williams, age 8 years; the said wife shall provide their support and education, relating the husband, H. G. Williams, of all his duty in respect therete; the said wife shall also provide her own support;
- and the property, both real and personal, standing in the name of the husband, and (or) in the name of both the husband and the wife, shall be the sole and absolute property of the husband; the wife hereby renounces all of her right to and claim of dower in and to all of said property, and any property that the husband may hereafter acquire, and this renunciation and relinquishment includes any and all statutory rights in lieu of dower; and the wife agrees to formally renounce dower on all mortgages, deeds, or other conveyances made heretofore or hereafter by the husband, upon his request for such renunciation;
- 4th. The husband H. G. Williams agrees to pay to the wife Barbara Williams, the following sums of money:
 - (a) Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars on or before January 1, 1950; and,
 - (b) Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars on or before January 1, 1952.

In event the husband fails to make the payments aforesaid, as aforesaid, the wife may, if she so elects, rescind this agreement, without returning any money already paid to her the reon.

5th. In event either party hereto institutes suit for divorce, the other party agrees to accept service of all necessary papers and process, and to submit to the jurisdiction of the Court.
