the First Pentecostal Church, a corporation,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid in the City of Greenville on Hampton Avenue, formerly West Street, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on Hampton Avenue and running thence with said street or Avenue S 42 1/2 E 101 feet to stake, thence S 49 1/4 W 144 feet to a stake, thence N 2 1/2 W 121 1/2 feet to a stake, thence N 57 E 144 feet to the beginning corner, less, however, a lot 50 feet in width heretofore conveyed to O. C. Williams by deed recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Book 72, page 38.
