

Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book K, Page 53 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Mest side of Mestview Avenue at joint front corner of Lots 22 and 23, Block 2, Section B, and running thence with the line of Lot 22 N. 89-0 W. 286 feet to point in branch; thence up said branch in a Northerly direction following the meanderings thereof 140 feet, more or less, to iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots 24 and 25; thence with line of Lot 25 S. 89-30 E. 244 feet to iron pin on the West side of Mestview Avenue; thence along the West side of Mestview Avenue S. 4-0 W. 170 feet to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of that property conveyed to E. R. rarker by deed of B. H. Burgess, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 220, Page 190. Subsequently, E. R. Parker died testate leaving his last will which is on file in the office of Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 488, File 25 and by said will he named and constituted the South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Greenville, S. C. as Executor, giving it full power to sell and convey the above described property, and accordingly the property was conveyed to me, Mary Moisson New on February 15, 1949 pursuant to the power and authority conferred on the South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Greenville, S. C. as Executor and Trustee by the terms of said will, and deed to same is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book, Page
