in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. H. Wilson, Clarice T. Wilson, Marjorie W. Ligon, S. E. Adams and W. H. Wallace, who are doing business under the name of Wilson Bonded Warehouse Company, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in or near the City of Greenville, and bounded as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the North side of a new cut road, which point is 15 feet west of the center line of the G. & W. C. Railroad, and from said point 15 feet to a point, which point is 15 feet from the center line of the G. & W. C. Railroad; thence S. 23-53 W. 157.5 feet to a point on the line of the W. H. Wilson Company warehouse at the north end of said warehouse; thence along the line of the north end of said warehouse, S. 61-17 E. 27.2 feet to the North end of said warehouse; thence S. 65-00 W. 157.5 feet to the North end of the platform on the east side of said warehouse; thence S. 65-00 W. 157.5 feet to the platform, S. 33-17 E. 71.2 feet to an angle of the platform; thence along the edge of said platform, S. 29-43 W. 67.3 feet to the North end of the warehouse; thence S. 10-16 W. 25.5 feet to the North end of the road; thence along the north edge of said new cut road, S. 83-00 E. 14.1 feet to the point of beginning, all as is shown on plat dated September 1, 1918.
