At Spartanburg, South Carolina this 21st day of December, 1948.

This matter coming on for hearing on an ORDER FOR FIRST MEETING OF CREDITORS, dated May 1, 1948; pursuant to said Order, a meeting was held May 18, 1948, at which it appeared from the testimony and statements of the attorneys for various creditors that there are no assets belonging to the said estate, except a one-half undivided interest in a house and lot known as 703 Beechwood Avenue, Greenville, South Carolina, the value of which would under no circumstances exceed Three Thousand Seven Hundred-Fifty (\$3,750.00) Dollars; that the same was conveyed by way of mortgages, to secure an indebtedness in excess of Four Thousand, Three Hundred Sixty-Five (\$4,365.00) Dollars; one mortgage held by the First Federal Savings and Loan Association of Greenville, South Carolina, securing an indebtedness of One Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-Five (\$1,365.00) Dollars; the other mortgage being held by Mrs. Leila Clayborne, securing an indebtedness of Three Thousand (\$3000.00) Dollars; and it further appears that no assets belonging to the said estate are discoverable.

The Court further finds that the exemptions to which the bankrupt is entitled by the law of the State of South Carolina, have been set off to him as prayed in his Petition filed herein.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That the said estate be declared one of no assets, and that the same be closed.
