to any of the poles erected by the J.P. Stevens & Co., Inc., on the property described, for local service, and, if so attached, the same to be done according to approved regulations and standards, so as not to interfere with the lines and service of the J.P. Stevens & Co., Inc.; and, if any such attachments are made, the grantors agree to thereafter bear one-half the costs of maintenance of the poles used jointly. It is further agreed that should the City of Greer or the Commission of Public Works of the City of Greer find it necessary to use the described property for some other municipal purpose requiring the removal of the transmission line, the said J.P. Stevens & Co., Inc., its successors and assigns, will remove the same within a reasonable time after notice thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the above described right, privilege, easement and right-of-way unto the said J.P. Stevens & Co., Inc., its successors and assigns, subject to the declared reservations.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Grantors hereto have caused these presents to be executed by their duly authorized officials, pursuant to a resolution of each body adopted at duly called meetings of the Council of the City of Greer and of the Commission of Public works of the City of Greer, at each meeting of which the foregoing agreement was discussed and approved.
