all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, lying North from the City of Greer and the  
new U.S. Highway No. 29 and also lying on the West side of South  
Carolina State Highway No. 14, and being all of lots Nos. 5 and 6  
and the northern one-half of lot No. 4 on a plat of property made  
for Margaret M. Green by H.L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated June 2, 1947,
