

(22) That tract in Glassy Mountain Township on head waters of South Pacolet River, containing  $47\frac{1}{2}$  acres; more or less, described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at a poplar on the line of lands now or formerly of R. E. Johnston and running thence West to a chestnut; thence northwest to a poplar; thence west to a walnut; thence south to a chestnut oak; thence east to an apple tree; thence northeast to the beginning corner.

This is the identical property conveyed to R. E. Johnston by deed dated June 11, 1904, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Vol. LLL at page 723.

(23) That tract of land in Glassy Mountain Township on the head waters of Vaughn's Creek of North Pacolet River, containing  $213\frac{1}{2}$  acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, according to a plat prepared by William E. Strong, C. E., dated December 5, 1903:

BEGINNING on a black oak stump, and running thence S.  $57\frac{1}{4}$  E. along line of the Widow Durham's land, 1116 feet to a stone; thence S.  $3\frac{1}{2}$  E. along line of the Warren Fisher land 14.00 feet to a stake; thence N.  $60\text{-}3/4$  W. 10.00 feet to a dark locust; thence S. 15 W. along the Luther Durham and Lockhart lands 3168 feet to a stone; thence N.  $69\text{-}40$  W. along the Pink Bellew lands 2204 feet to a stone; thence N. 7.20 E. 320 feet to an oak; thence N.  $20.40$  E. 549 feet to a chestnut oak; thence N.  $80\frac{1}{2}$  along the Lindsey lands 420 feet to a stone; thence N.  $17\frac{1}{2}$  E. 600 feet to a sourwood; thence N.  $8\frac{1}{2}$  E. 1352 feet to a stake; thence N. 64.00 E. along line of William Fisher lands 2156 feet to the beginning corner.
