part of that tract of land conveyed to Peter Shorter by S. J. Douthitt,  
deed bearing date of December 2nd, 1878, and by Peter Shorter conveyed  
to G. W. Browning and by G. W. Browning conveyed to W. H. Williams by  
deed bearing date of December 1st, 1882.
