NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That SLATER MANUFACTURING CO., INC., a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, in consideration of the premises and of other good and valuable consideration to it in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. P. STEVENS & CO., INC., a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc., its successors and assigns:
