


County, State of South Carolina located about three miles northwest from Irser, being bounded on the north by other lands of myself, on the east by lands of E. R. Taylor, on the south by lands of Will Vaughm and lands now or formerly of J. P. Taylor and on the west by lands of E. R. Taylor, being the rear portion of the same land that was converse to me by deed recorded in the office of the R. M. J. for Greenville County in Deed Book 105 at page 513, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-

Beginning on an old stone corner on the J. T. Taylor line and joint corner of E. R. Taylor land (the said stone being the southwest corner of my original tract), and runs there with the Taylor and Vaughm line C. 36-35 E. 1638 feet to a louble Sparish Oak Stump, joint corner of another tract of E. R. Paylor; thence with the E. R. Taylor line M. 6-37 W. 526 feet to an iron pin on the said line and south from the creek; thence a new line S. 62-80 W/ 598.5 feet to an iron pin; thence another new line S. 70-00 /.667 feet to an iron pin on the L. R. Taylor line; there e with this line S. 18-45 E. 152 feet to the beginning corner, and containing Seven and sixty seven one-hundredths (7.67) acres, more or less.
