TOTAL DIVORCE JUDGMENT AND DECREE

Upon consideration of the above entitled case, no defense having been filed and no jury trial demanded by either party, on the evidence submitted it is the judgment of the Court that a total divorce be granted between the parties: that is to say, a divorce a vinculo matrimonii, upon legal principles.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DECREED by the Court that the marriage contract heretofore entered into between the parties to said case is hereby set aside and dissolved as fully and effectually as if no such contract had ever been made and entered into.

ORDERED FURTHER, that the Plaintiff and the Defendant, formerly husband and wife, in the future be held and considered as a separate and distinct persons altogether unconnected by any nuptial union or civil contract whatsoever.

The rights and disabilities of the parties are fixed as follows: The Plaintiff shall be at liberty to marry again and the Defendant shall, shall be at liberty to marry again.

ORDERED FURTHER, that the wife's maiden name be restored to her, to-wit:

Annie Mae Wolfe

The Court awards custody of the children of the parties as follows:

The Court fixes alimony and support for the wife and children as follows:

This judgment shall be held in suspense for thirty (30) days. If after (30) days from this date, no person at interest has filed in this Court a written petition setting forth sufficient grounds for modification or setting aside this judgment, it shall become of full force and effect.

ORDERED FURTHER, that the defendant pay the costs of these proceedings,
