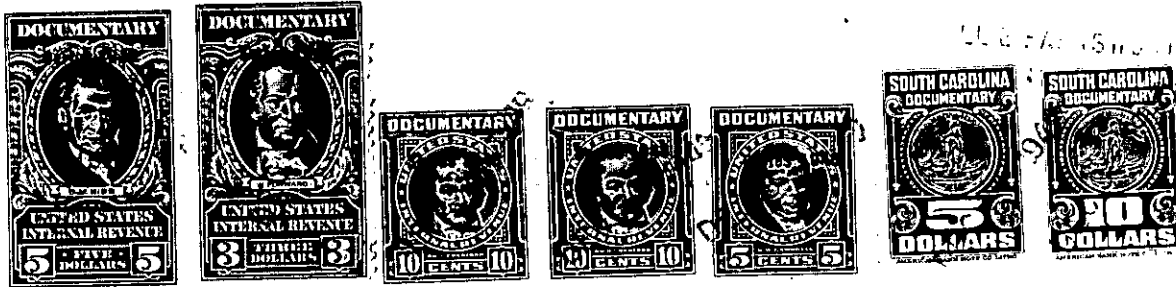

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina on the Northeast corner of Bennett Street and  
Boxwood Road near the City of Greenville being shown as lot number 15  
on plat of Northwood made by Dalton & Neves in June 1939, recorded  
in Plat Book "J" at page 102 and described as follows:  
BEGINNING at a stake at the Northeast corner of Bennett Street and  
Boxwood Road and running thence with the North side of Boxwood Road,  
S. 71-32 E. 150 feet to a stake at corner of lot number 17; thence with  
the line of said lot N. 19-30 E. 60.7 feet to a stake at corner of lot  
number 16; thence with line said lot N. 70-47 W. 150 feet to a stake  
on Bennett Street; thence with the Eastern side of Bennett Street, S.  
19-30 W. 32 feet to the beginning corner. This is the same lot of
