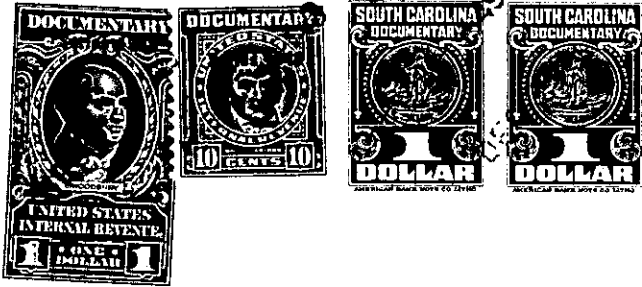

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Grover Lee Harrison and his
Heirs and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, beginning at a rock in the road on George
Adams line, running thence nearly East in a straight line to a
black gum; thence south to a pine; thence southwest to a poplar
corner; thence nearly East with the Big Road to a Black Gum corner;
thence nearly West with W. M. S. Robertson's line to George Adams'
line; thence North with George Adams' line to the beginning rock
corner, containing 25 acres, more or less, known as the Frank Holly
Place.
