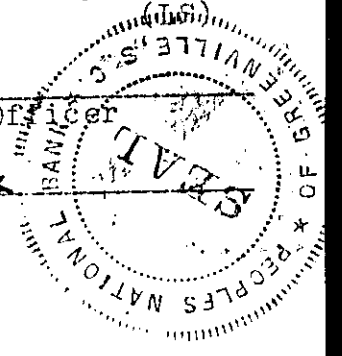


Life Insurance Company, so long as it holds a mortgage on the property above described.
