CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION  
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

D.C. BAILEY, DAN D. DAVENPORT and DR. M.A. DRUMMOND,  
all of Greer, S.C.,

two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of

## MEMORIAL METHODIST CHURCH, INCORPORATED

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 19th day of  
August, A. D. 1949, file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the Greer Citizen, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is MEMORIAL METHODIST CHURCH, INCORPORATED

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is GREER, S.C.

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to maintain a place of divine worship of the Methodist ministry and members of the Methodist Church, in support of the doctrine and subject to the laws, usages and ministerial appointments of the Methodist Church as from time to time established, made and declared by the lawful authority of said Church.

FIFTH: The names and residences of all Managers, Trustees, Directors or other officers are as follows:

SIXTH: That they desire to be incorporated: in perpetuity.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, W.P. Blackwell, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested, by Chapter 158, Article III, Code of 1942, and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby declare the said organization to be a body politic and corporate, with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities, conferred by said Chapter 158, Article III, Sections 8158-8159 and 8168, Code of 1942, and Acts amendatory thereto.
