all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about ten miles north of Greer, S. C., and situated on the north side of the public road leading from Pleasant Hill Baptist Church to the Old Greenville road, and described as follows:

BEGINNING On my line at the rock bridge, and running with said road in an easterly direction approximately 1060 feet to a small branch; thence up said branch as the line in a northerly direction approximately 620 feet to a stone, corner of my land and that of John Crain; thence in a westerly direction approximately 200 feet to a walnut tree; thence a little south of west approximately 360 feet to a crab apple tree; thence in a southerly direction approximately 820 feet to the beginning corner, and containing nine (9) acres, more or less, and being a part of the same land conveyed to me by S.
