all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville, Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina :

Being designed as a Part of Lot 57 (dwelling
theron being know as 16 Palmetto Street) on plat of lands of
West End Land and Improvement Company, recorded in office of
R. M. C. for Greenville County, in plat Book 'A' page 153, and
said lot having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an
iron pin on the West side of Palmetto Street, 596 feet from the
intersection of Palmetto Street and McKay Street, starting at
the joint corner of Lots 56 and 57, running along Palmetto
