All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southern side of Brookside Way in a subdivision known as Marshall Forest, being described according to a plat prepared by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, dated December 12, 1949, entitled "Property of Mrs. G. L. Prevost, located in Marshall Forest in the City of Greenville, S. C.", and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Brookside Way at the joint front corner of the property herein conveyed and property of Harry S. Collinson, Jr. and June W.
