all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mt. Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as lot No. 9,
of a sub-division known as High View Acres, a plat of which is of
record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book
O, at Page 123, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the eastern side of Courtland Drive, the
joint front corner of lots Nos. 8 and 9, said beginning point being
1155.6 feet north of the northeastern intersection of Courtland
Drive and Sulpher Springs Road, and running thence with the joint
line of lots Nos. 8 and 9, S. 84-30 E. 652 feet to a point; thence
N. 5-41 E. 200 feet to a point, the joint rear corner of lots Nos.
9 and 10; thence with the joint line of lots Nos. 9 and 10, N. 84-
30 W. 652.6 feet to a point on the eastern side of Courtland Drive;
