This contract made and entered into this 14th day of February, 1950, between W. S. Batson, Jr., as Trustee for M. G. Batson, hereinafter referred to as the Seller and E. P. Batson, hereinafter referred to as the Purchaser, witnesseth:

That in and for the total consideration of eighteen thousand dollars, the Seller hereby agrees to sell and convey to the Purchaser, the following described real estate in Greenville County, to-wit:
