"All that piece, parcel and tract of land, situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, adjoining lands of T. H. Shipman, J. H. Gosnell and William Wilkins, being described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on pipe line and thence running S. 80 W. 2250 chains; thence S. 22 E. 423 to iron pin; thence S. 75 W. 1187 to iron pin; thence S. 41 W. 2130 to iron pin on branch; thence down branch, S. 27 chains to iron pin on same branch; thence N. 43 W. 11.40 to iron pin; thence S. 84 W. 4.40 chains to a stone; thence N. 48 W. 9.50 chains to a Sycamore tree and south Saluda River; thence up the meanders of said river to a stone at mouth of branch, William Wilkins! corner; thence up the branch as the line to a stake Pointers; thence S. 81.57 E. 273 to a Poplar stump; thence N. 82-23 E. 13.48; thence to the beginning and contains 164 acres, more or less, and being the same property conveyed to E.
