Butler, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of ten dollars to US in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by deacons of Locust Baptist Church and their successors (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said deacons of Locust Baptist Church, their successors,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oneal Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances:

Beginning on an iron pin in the road leading to Greer, thence N. 38.45 E. 385 1/2 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 52.45 W. 176 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 68.30 W. 69 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 77.30 W. 228 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 64.45 W. 60 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 40.15 W. 238 feet to an iron pin in above said road, thence S. 45.00 E. 60 feet to a point in said road, thence S. 51.00 E. 418 feet to an iron pin, then beginning corner.
