presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Margaret Ray Atkins and Robert  
L. Atkins, their Heirs and Assigns forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, located near Washington Baptist Church, lying  
on the north side of the road that leads from Washington Church to  
O'Neal, being bounded on the west and north by other lands of my-  
self, on the east by lands of Hattie Roe Henderson and on the south  
by the said road and other lands formerly of myself, and being a  
part of the same land that was conveyed to me by deed recorded in  
the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 34  
at page 231, and having the following courses and distances, to  
wit:-

Beginning on a point in the center of the said road and on  
the common line of Hattie Roe Henderson and myself, and runs thence  
with the said line N. 7-40 E. 325 feet to an iron pin on the said  
line (iron pin also on the bank of the road at 21 feet); thence

316 feet to a point in the center of the said road (iron pin back on  
line at 16.5 feet); thence with the center of the said road, N. 84-  
15 E. 116 feet to the beginning corner, and containing One(1) acre,
