all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
 County, State of South Carolina, School District 9-H, on the northern side of
Vandeventer Drive (or Street), and being a portion of lot #14 on plat
 of the property of grantor, prepared by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor,
 February 24, 1942, and having the following courses and distances,
 to-wit:-

Beginning, on northern edge of said Drive or Street, at corner of
Bright lot, and runs thence with that line, N 0-17 W one hundred
