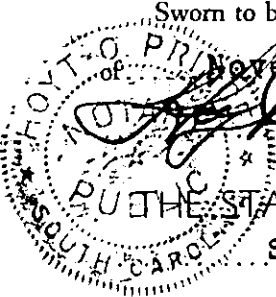

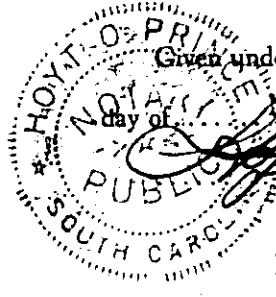
Renunciation of Dower
