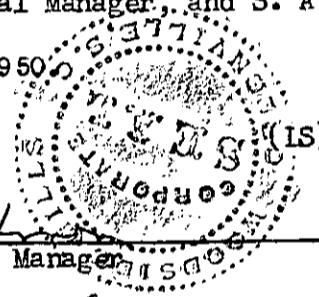

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto Parker Water & Sewer Sub-District Commission and the Commissioners of Public Works of the City of Greenville, S. C., their successors, successors in office and assigns; subject, however, to the time limitation hereinabove set forth.
