AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into by and between William Frank CREENTILLE.

Nalley, of Easley, South Carolina, hereinafter designated as "husband", and Eileen Chastain Nalley, of Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter designated as "wife".

WHEREAS, unhappy differences have arisen between the husband and wife, by reason whereof they have agreed to live separate and apart from each other for the future, and to enter into the agreement hereinafter contained:

WITNESSETH

That in pursuance of said agreement and for the consideration herein appearing and the mutual benefits of both, they hereby agree that:

- 1. It shall be lawful for the wife at all times hereinafter to live separate and apart from the husband and free from his marital control and authority, as if she were sole and unmarried, and to reside from time to time at such places as she might deem proper, without any interference whatever on the part of the husband.
- 2. Neither of them, the husband and wife, shall molest the other of them, nor compel, or endeavor to compel, the other of them to cohabit or dwell with him or her by any legal proceedings for restitution of conjugal rights or otherwise whatsoever.
- 3. If either the husband or wife institutes any proceeding for a judicial separation or for an absolute divorce in any court whatsoever, each shall retain any grounds that now exist for such legal separation or absolute divorce and specifically reserves and does not waive by this agreement such grounds.
- 4. That there are no children involved in this proceeding, and both parties are of age and suffering from no mental infirmity, and the wife hereby agrees that in the event a proceeding for a judicial separation or an absolute divorce is instituted in any court, that no alimony will be requested, and she specifically waives her right to claim alimony or support from the husband so long as he shall abide by the terms of this agreement.
