to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George W. Conwell,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the south side of the Old Anderson Road, about three miles south of the city of Greenville on State Highway No. 81, being shown as the eastern portion of tract No. 14 on plat of Dixie Farms, and having according to a recent survey by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, the following notes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Old Anderson Road, the same being the joint front corner of lots 14 and 14 A, and running thence with the joint line of said lots S. 18-22 E. 1020.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 74-30 W. 438 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 71-15 W. 67 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 8-33 E. 946.3 feet to an iron pin on Old Anderson Road; thence with the South side of said Old Anderson Road, N. 70-18 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence with the said road as the line N. 62-49 E. 106.8 feet to the point of beginning.
