

O. McDowell, Jr., dated December, 1944, which plat is recorded in Plat Book "M", at Page 107, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Washington Loop, joint front corner of Lots # 5 and # 6; thence along joint line of said lots S. 21-00 E. 125 feet to iron pin in right of way of old Bed of Southern Railway; thence N. 77-30 E. 50 feet to iron pin, Southwest corner of Lot # 7; thence along line of Lot # 7 N. 20 W.1455feet to an iron pin to South side of Washington Loop; thence along said Washington Loop S. 53-03 W. 54.2 feet to the beginning corner. Also, all right, title and interest of the Grantor in and to that certain Southern Railway Bed or right of way, which joins the above described lot on the South end thereof.
