In consideration of the rentals' hereinafter provided, Traver Real Estate Co. has granted, demised and leased, and by these presents does lease and demise unto Traver Motor Co. all that piece, parcel or lot of land, together with the improvements thereon, situate lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the west side of Westfield Street, having a frontage of eight; feet on said street, to be used by said Lessee in connection with the operation of its business.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto the said Lessee for the term of simily months beginning January 1, 1947 and ending December 31, 1951.

The Lessee agrees to pay to the Lessor, as rental on said premises during the term of said lease, the sum of \$200.00 per month, payable at the end of each calendar month.
