 | APPOINTMENT OF TRUSTEE
COUNTY OF GREENVILLE. |

WHEREAS, Cherokee Land Company by its deed dated November 30, 1917, recorded in Deed Book 33, at page 328, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County did convey unto L. O. Patterson as Trustee certain lots and parcels of land therein mentioned and described being all of those lots or tracts conveyed to Cherokee Land Company by deed dated July 17, 1906, recorded in Deed Book SSS, page 593; and conveyed to Cherokee Land Company by deed dated May 21, 1914, recorded in Deed Book 21, Page 574, except certain lots that had been conveyed.

WHEREAS, the beneficial owners under the said Trust Deed were L. O. Patterson, F. T. Dargan, H. K. Townes, and J. R. Ware, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, and;

WHEREAS since the execution of said deed of Trust L. O. Patterson died, leaving a will wherein his wife Andrea C. Patterson was bequeathed and devised his whole estate; F. T. Dargan died intestate leaving his sole heirs at law, his wife Gillette T. Dargan and his daughter, Elizabeth T. Sams; J. R. Ware died intestate leaving his sole heirs at law his wife, Eliza D. Ware, his children, Henry L. Ware, Marion D. Ware, Mary W. Vorus and Anna W. Boatwright.

WHEREAS, said Trust Deed or instrument provided upon the death of said Trustee then the majority in interest of the beneficial owners, or their heirs, executors, administrations or assigns should appoint a new Trustee to carry out the provision of the said Deed of Trust. Now therefore;

IN CONSIDERATION OF the premises and ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) to the undersigned beneficiaries of the said Trust the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the undersigned beneficiaries of said Trust being majority in interest as provided by said Trust Deed do hereby constitute and appoint H. K. Townes as Trustee for said land described being all of the said land except those parcels of land which have been conveyed therefrom as will appear by recorded deeds in the R. M. C.
