of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Lala F. Putman for her life and at her death to Longview, Inc.,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville
State of South Carolina, near the town of Fountain Inn, and having the
following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at corner of lot owned by Mrs. N. E. McDowell
and running thence N. 84 E. 6.47 to corner of lot belonging to Mrs. S. C.
Fulmer; thence S. 7-3/4 E. 4.28 to an iron pin; thence N. 86 1/4 E. 2.39 to
corner of lot belonging to M. M. Stephens; thence S. 2 W. 16.01 to corner
of lands of John R. Harrison; thence S. 85 1/4 W. 8.41 to corner of lands of
Mrs. M. M. Armstrong (formerly owned by L. P. Armstrong); thence N. 26 W.
19.00 to center of Georgia Road; thence N. 71 1/2 E. 7.54 to beginning corner.
