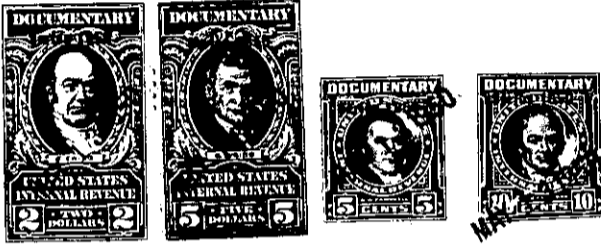
to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said "J."C. Balcombe, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the East side of Irene Circle, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot 35, on plat of Royal Heights, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April 1949, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "W", at page 25, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the East side of Irene Circle at joint front corner of Lots 35 and 36, and running thence with the line of Lot 36, N 85-21 E 170.84 feet to a stake; thence N 00-30 W 70.18 feet to a stake at corner of Lot 34; thence with the line of said lot, S 85-21 W 175.9 feet to a stake on the East side of Irene Circle; thence with the East side of Irene Circle, S 4-39 E 70 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to the grantor by deed of Irene B. Ducker, dated December 8, 1949, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., at page 439, in Deed Book 403.
