

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in or near the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being more particularly described as Lot 9, Section B, as shown on a plat entitled "A Subdivision for Woodside Mills, Greenville, S. C.", made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, Greenville, S. C., January 14, 1950, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book W, at pages 111-117, inclusive. According to said plat the within described lot is also known as No. 57 West Sixth Street (Avenue) and fonts thereon

The granter and its predecessors in title have granted unto Parker Water & Sewer Sub-District Commission, Commissioners of Public Works of the City of Greenville, S. G. - (2) That only one residence shall be erected or maintained on any one lot.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Héreditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantec(s) hereinabove named, and his (her or their) Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the said Woodside Mills does hereby bind fiself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the gruntee(s) hereinaboye named, and his (her or their) heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomseever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
