 more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe on the south side of Court Street, 48.1 feet  
 from River Street and running thence with Court Street, S. 70-20 E. 48.1  
 feet to iron pipe, corner of Lot No. 3, 103.8 feet from Jackson Street;  
 thence with line of Lot No. 3, S. 19-55 W. 117.5 feet to iron pipe in  
 line of right of way of Southern Railway side track; thence with said
