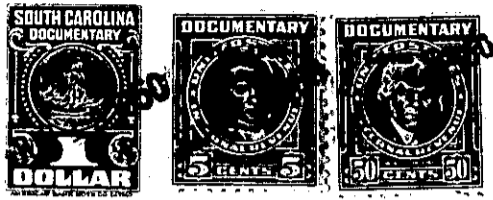

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That we, Wade H. Poole, Rosa Lee Poole, G. H. Poole and Delle Poole, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Lee Roy Moody (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lee Roy Moody

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Cleveland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the waters of Gap Creek, bounded by lands of the grantee on the southeast, and lands of the grantors on the southwest, being a portion of a tract of land containing thirty (30) acres, more or less, conveyed to the grantor, G. H. Poole, by S. B. Johnson, by deed dated May 13, 1924, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 92, at page 404. It being the intention of the grantors to convey all of their interests of any kind in said tract of thirty acres less a portion having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a point in Gap Creek Road and running thence N. 75-05 E. 64 feet to a point in said road; thence N. 72-55 E. 205 feet to a point in said road; thence N. 17-0 E. 515 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 43-45 W. 1153 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 26-30 E. 1590 feet to the point of beginning, and a portion thereof containing ten (10) acres, more or less, heretofore conveyed to the grantee by deed dated June 14, 1944, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 264, at page 338.
