FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is BURRELL'S PERENNIAL GARDENS

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is producing for sale perennial plants and flowers and the operation of a general florist business.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is One Thousand (\$1,000.00) - - - - - Dollars payable in cash or its equivalent.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is One Hundred (100) of the par value of Ten (\$10.00) - - - - - Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 14th day of July, 1950, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors:

Frank Raysor, G. C. Burrell and Ruby Y. Burrell

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, G. C. Burrell ;
as Vice-President, Frank Raysor ; as Secretary, Ruby Y. Burrell ;
as Treasurer, Frank Raysor

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1942, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greenville Piedmont

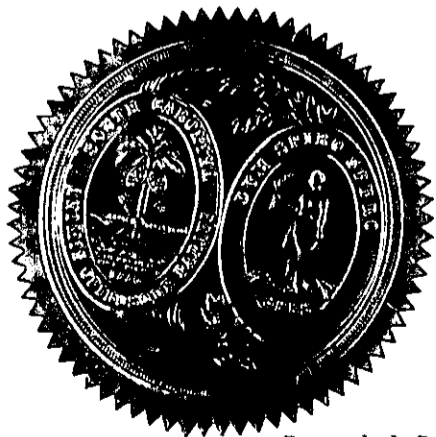
