to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lillian E. Summey, all my right, title and interest in and to:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, lying and being situate on the Southern side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue, within the limits of the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot #122, Pleasant Valley, according to plat of said sub-division prepared by Dalton & Neves in April, 1946, including additions to said Plat through November, 1948, as recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "P", at Page 92, and having, according to said plat, the following notes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue at joint front corner of Lots #121 and #122, said pin being 470 feet Northeast of iron pin in the Southeast corner of the intersection of Pleasant Ridge Avenue with Panama Avenue; thence S. 0-03 E. 160 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots #121 and #122; thence N. 0-52 E. 60 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots #122 and #123; thence N. 0-03 W. 160 feet to an iron pin at joint front corner of Lots #122 and #123 on the southern side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue; thence along said Avenue S. 30-52 W. 60 feet to iron pin at joint front corner of Lots #121 and #122, the point of beginning, this being the same piece of property decided to me and my wife, Lillian E. Summey, on April 6, 1950, by deed recorded in Deed Book 406, Page 271, in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.
