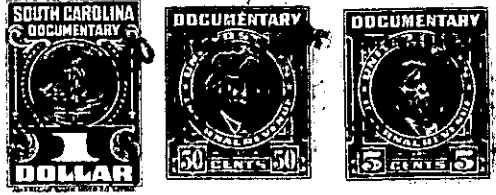

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Marshall W. Balliew

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oneal Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina lying on east side of a county road and bounded
on the north by land of Hampton Dill and on the three sides by other
land of Grantor, containing 0.95 Acre, more or less, and having
the following Metes and Bounds:

Beginning at a nail and cap in center of road witnessed by
Iron pins on property line on both sides of road on Hampton
Dill's line and running thence S. 49-45 E. 221.4 feet to iron pin;
thence S. 33-51 W. 176.1 feet to iron pin; thence N. 56-09 W.
220 feet over iron pin on bank of road to a Nail and cap in center
of road; thence along road N. 33-51 E. 200 feet to beginning.
