necessary to maintaining its service as a telephone system within the town of Simpsonville and to such other persons, firms, or corporations without the corporate limits of the town of Simpsonville to whom it may care to furnish service.

SECTION 3. That the use as aforesaid of the streets, sidewalks, alleys and public places of the town of Simpsonville shall be exercised in such manner as not to interfere to any unreasonable extent in the use of same by the public for the purposes for which they have been dedicated and are now used, and that the town council of the Town of Simpsonville reserves to itself the right, after due notice, to repair any damage to the street, sidewalks, and public places of the Town of Simpsonville caused by the use of same as aforesaid and may charge the costs of same to the said Home Telephone Company of Simpsonville Inc., its successors, upon its failure, after due notice, to make such repairs itself.

SECTION 4. That said Home Telephone Company of Simpsonville,
Inc., its successors, shall in the exercise of the rights, privileges and
franchises herein granted be at all times subject to such reasonable
Ordinances as may be now in force or hereafter passed relative to the use
of the public streets, sidewalks, alleys, and other public places to make them
safe and suitable for public travel.

SECTION 5. That said Home Telephone Company of Simpsonville, Inc. shall during the term of this franchise furnish telephones and telephone service to all persons, firms, or corporations residing within the Town of Simpsonville, who may apply in writing for same and comply with all uniform and reasonable rules which are now in force and which may be established for the conduct of the telephone business upon prompt payment of the usual rental price required for the service.
